So this award-winning Warwickshire gallery has six permanent collections: Naples, Northern European Art 1450-1650, British Portraits, Chinese, British Folk Art & The Marx-Lambert Collection. This includes the largest collection of folk art in Britain. Pretty impressive! What's more, it's based in a Georgian mansion set amidst 120 acres of 'Capability' Brown parkland. The scenery is breath-taking — as is the art you'll see.

We've booked a mini cream tea on arrival — scones, jam, cream and a cuppa — after which you'll be free to do whatever you like. There is a café, with fresh, local, seasonal food, as well as a gift shop.
